Download **Winaero Tweaker** only from it's home page only as some other download sites could include some unwanted inclusions or viruses.

Every time you create a new **shortcut**, **Windows** appends the "- shortcut" text to its name. e.g. the **shortcut** for **totalcmd.exe** becomes named "**totalcmd.exe - shortcut**". It is possible to disable the "- shortcut" suffix for any **shortcuts** you create after disabling it. Any existing **shortcut** with the "- shortcut" text will have to be manually renamed.

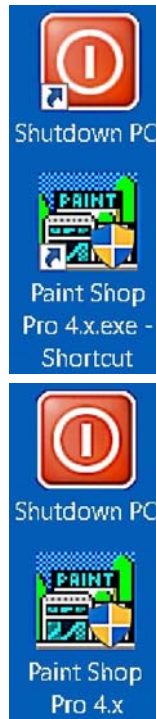
How to disable "- Shortcut" Text on desktop shortcuts. Run **Winaero Tweaker** (see image shown below), scroll down to **File Explorer**, click on **Disable "- Shortcut" Text** (see image below). In the right panel tick: **Disable "- Shortcut" text for shortcuts**.

In the right panel click on [See in detail how this tweak works](#) for more detailed information on selected Tweak/s. While on that page you can also [Download Registry files](#) which is an alternative to either **Disable** or **Restore** "- Shortcut Text".

**Right-Click** on **Disable** or **Restore** and **Merge**.

The image above shows **shortcut arrows** on the icons plus "- Shortcut Text" while the one below shows **Shortcut Text** removed.



**Remove shortcut arrow ...**

**Shortcuts** in **Windows** have an **arrow** overlaid on top of the icon to indicate that they are links. If you find the default **Windows 10 shortcut icon** too large, or you wish to change the **shortcut arrow** from the default blue **arrow overlay** to a smaller one, then you can do that easily. You can even disable the **shortcut arrow** completely.

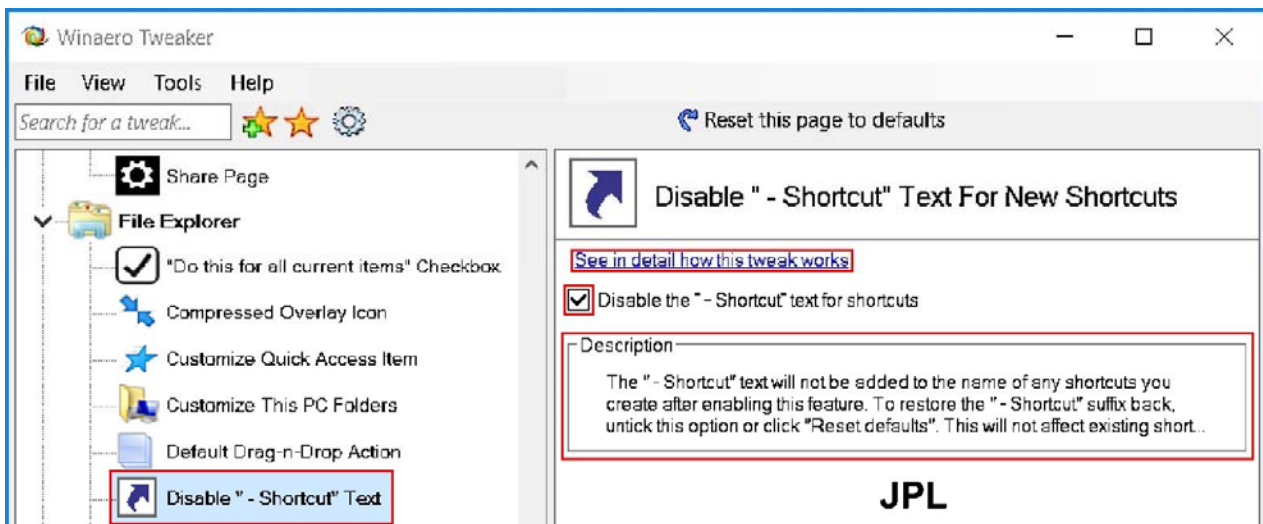

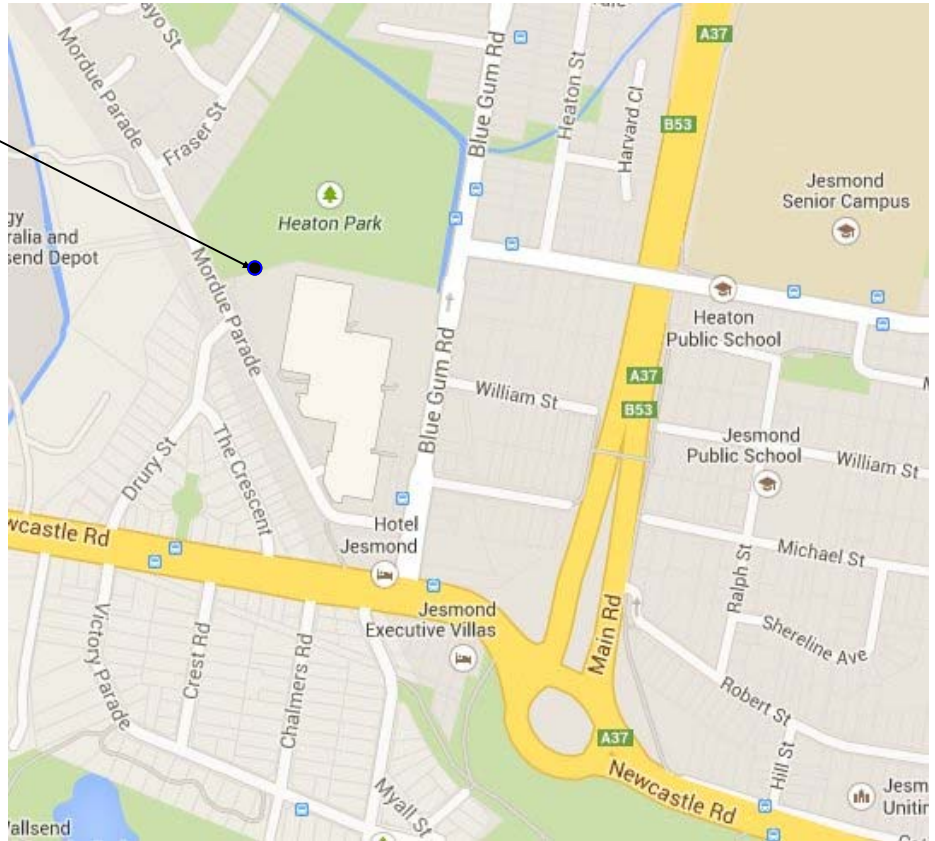
